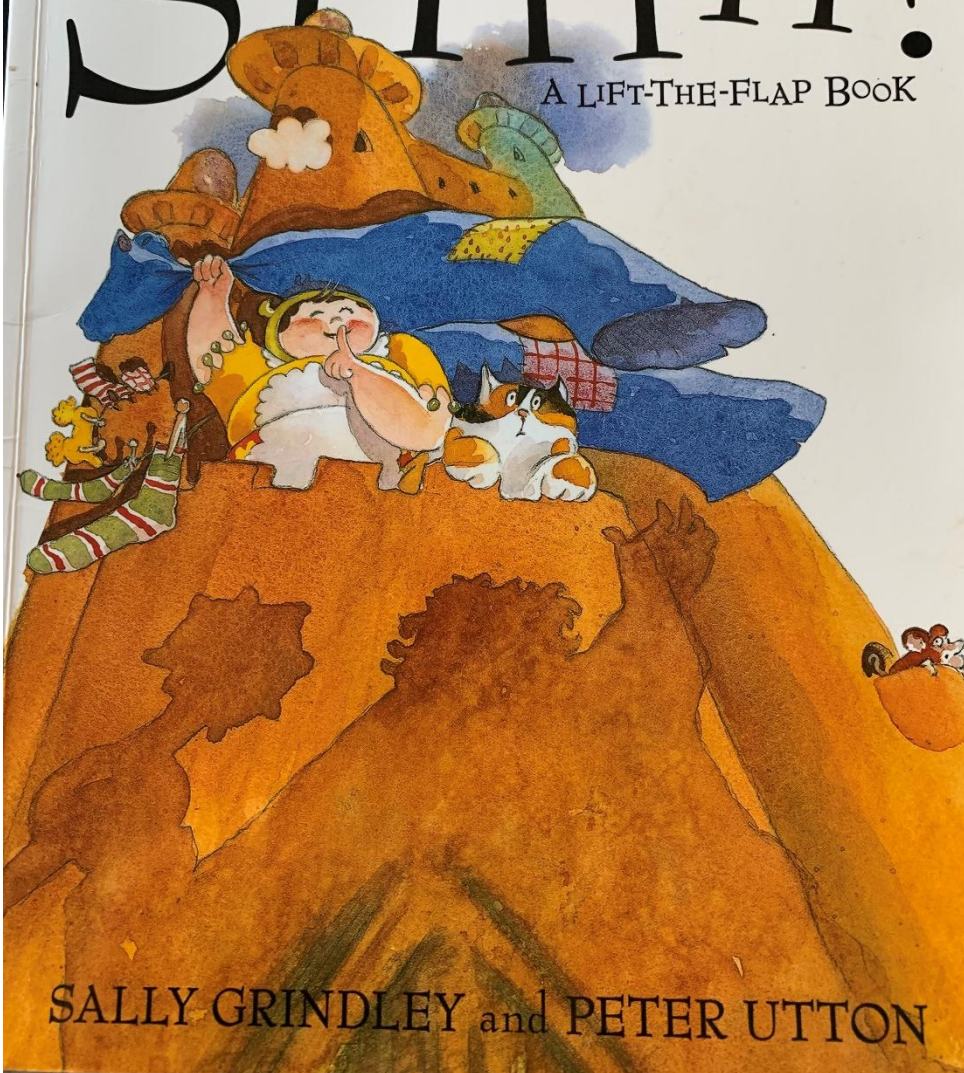


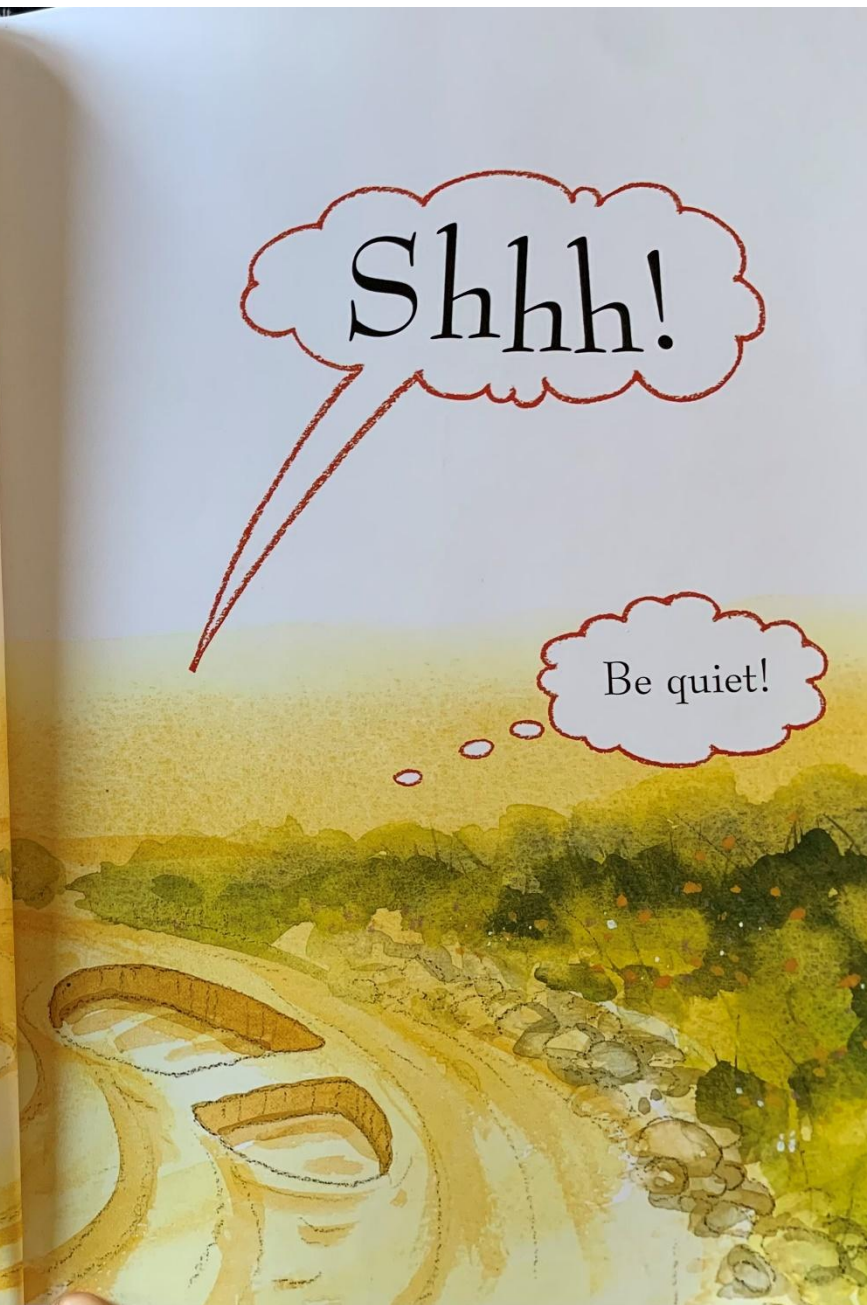

Be quiet!

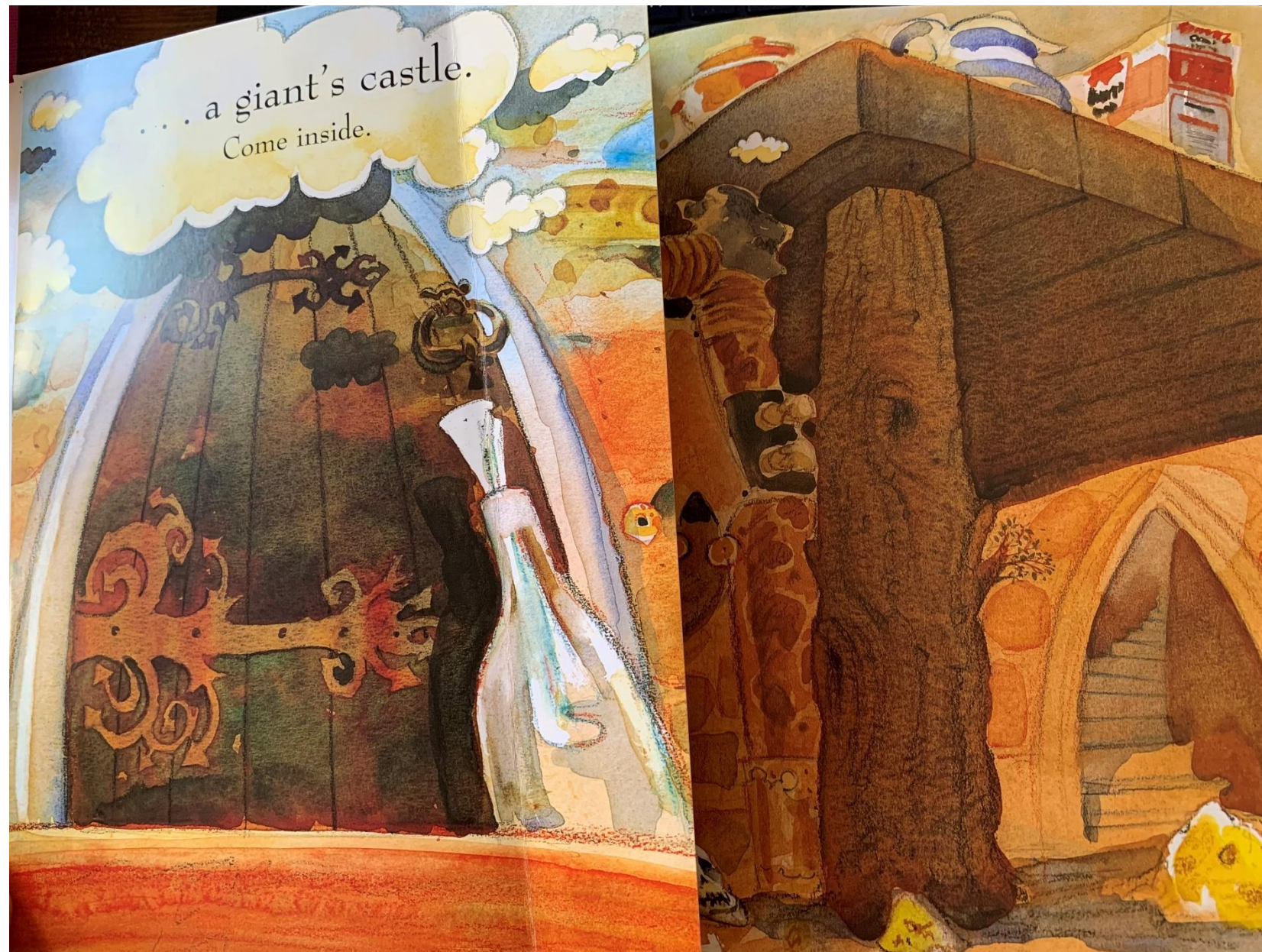





Shhh!

to enter . . .









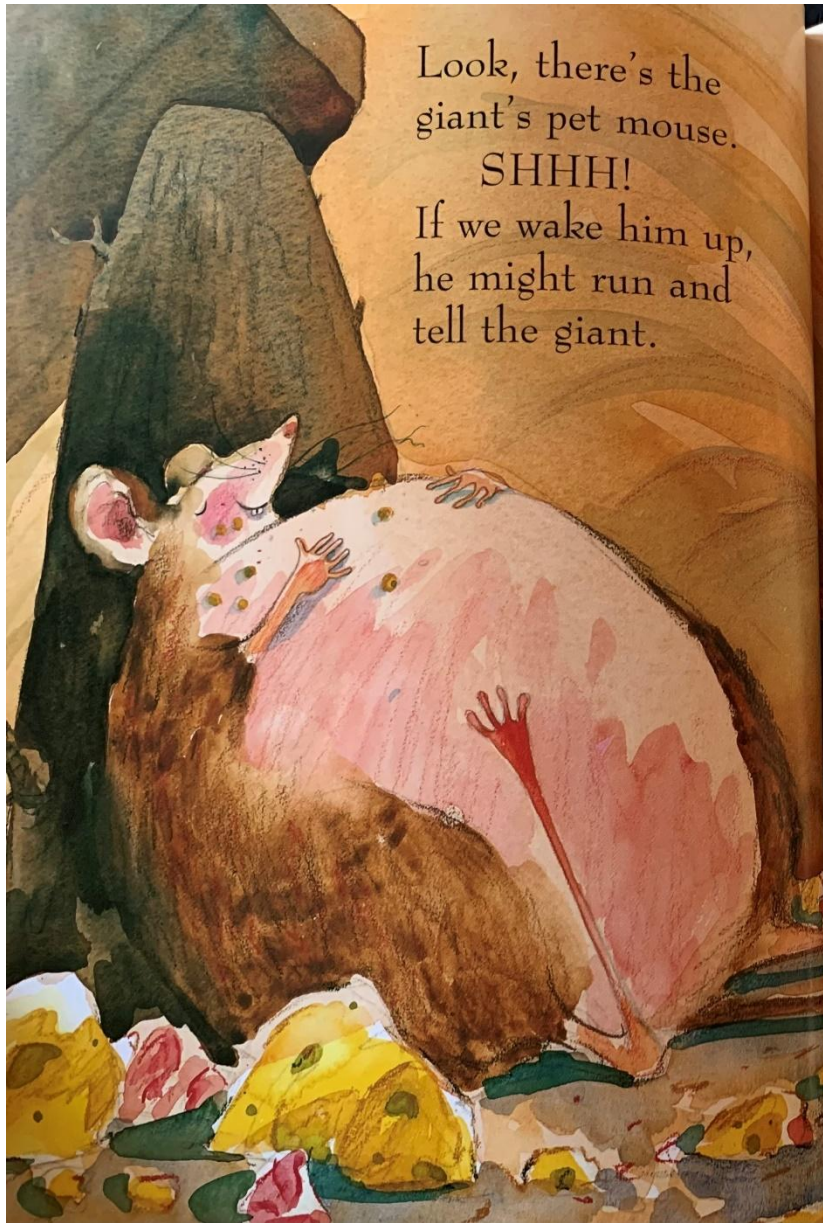
Now, you must be QUIET!

SHHH!



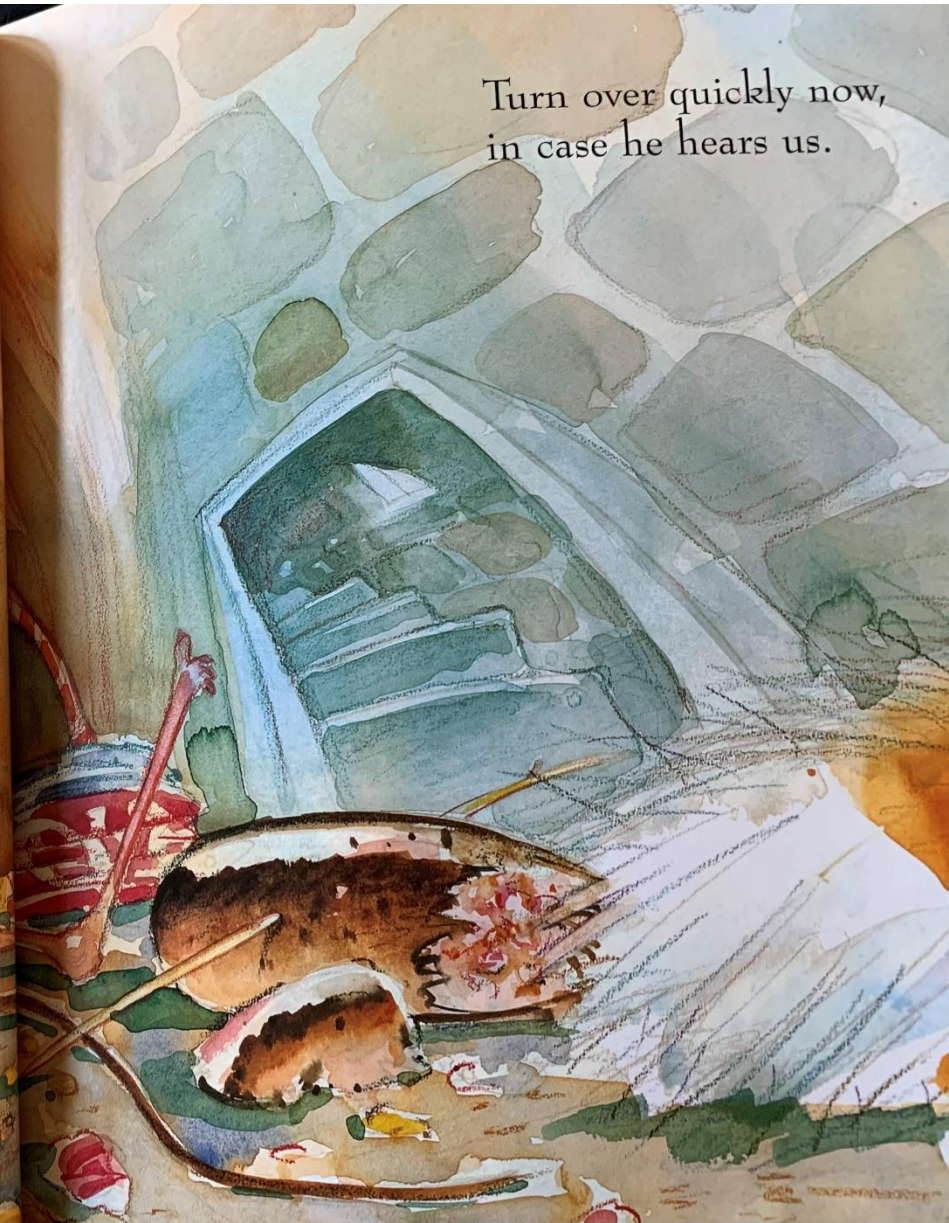
Look, there's the

in case he hears us.

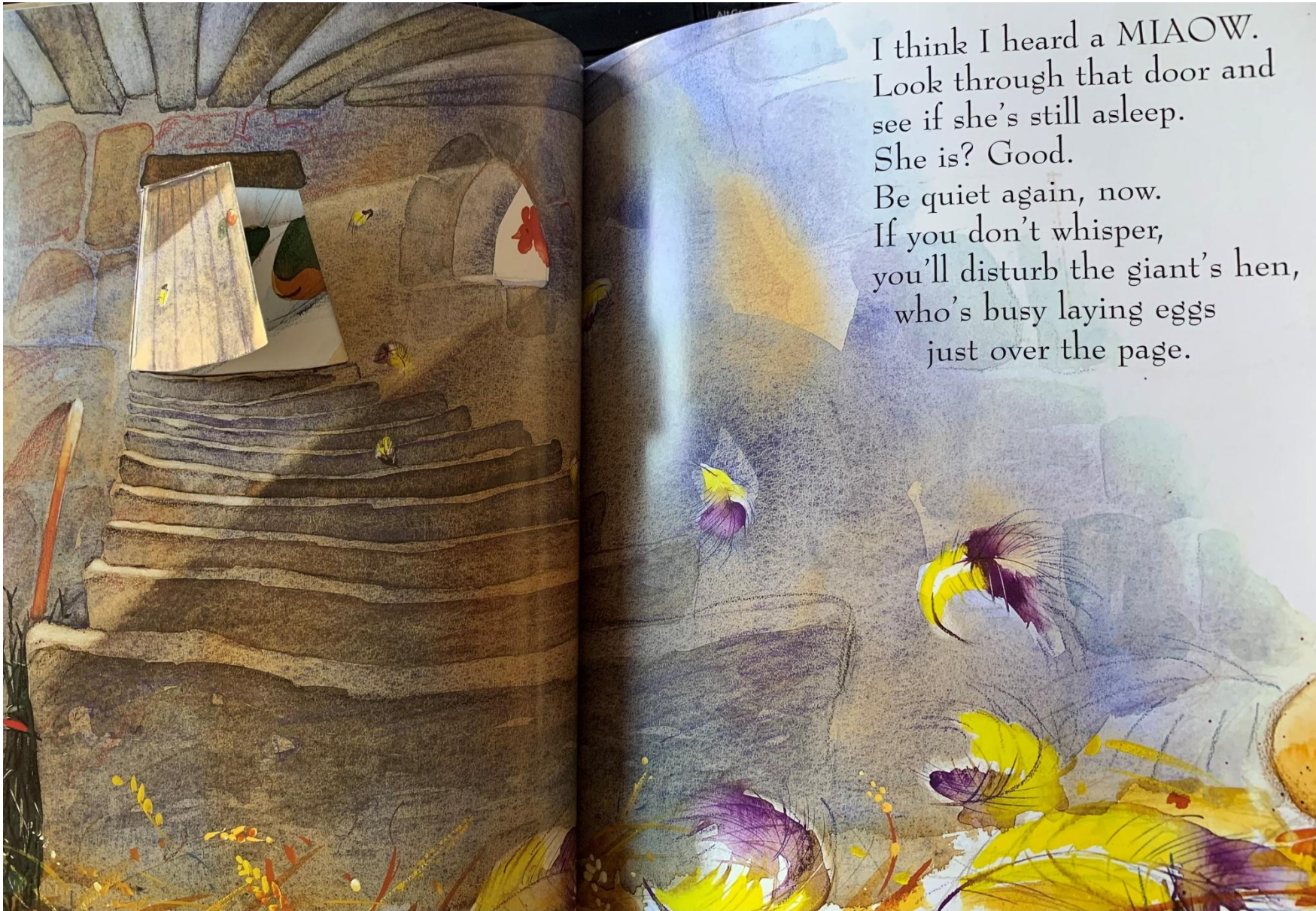




And there's the giant's cat.

Good.

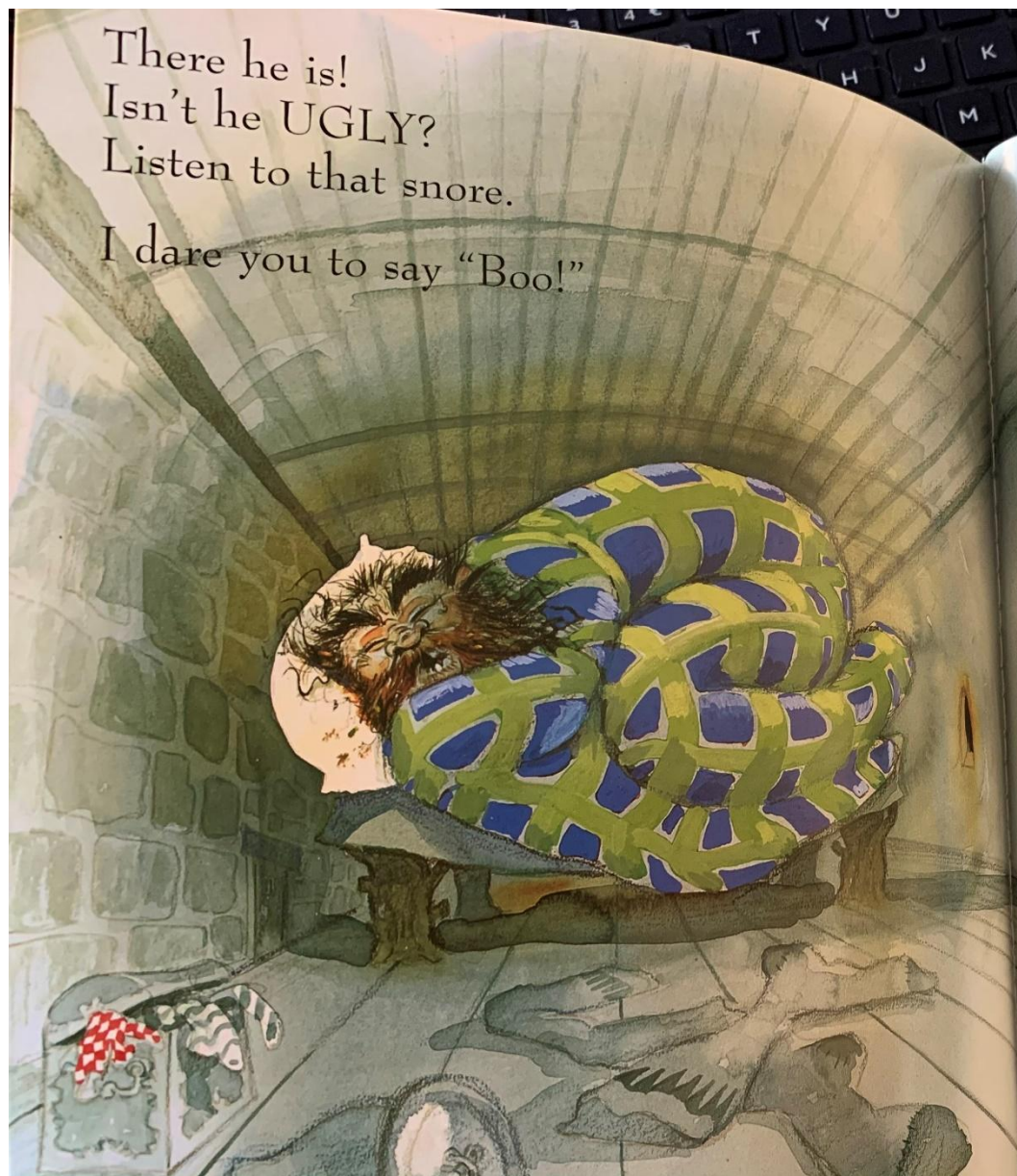


Be quiet again, now.

I dare you to say "Boo!"

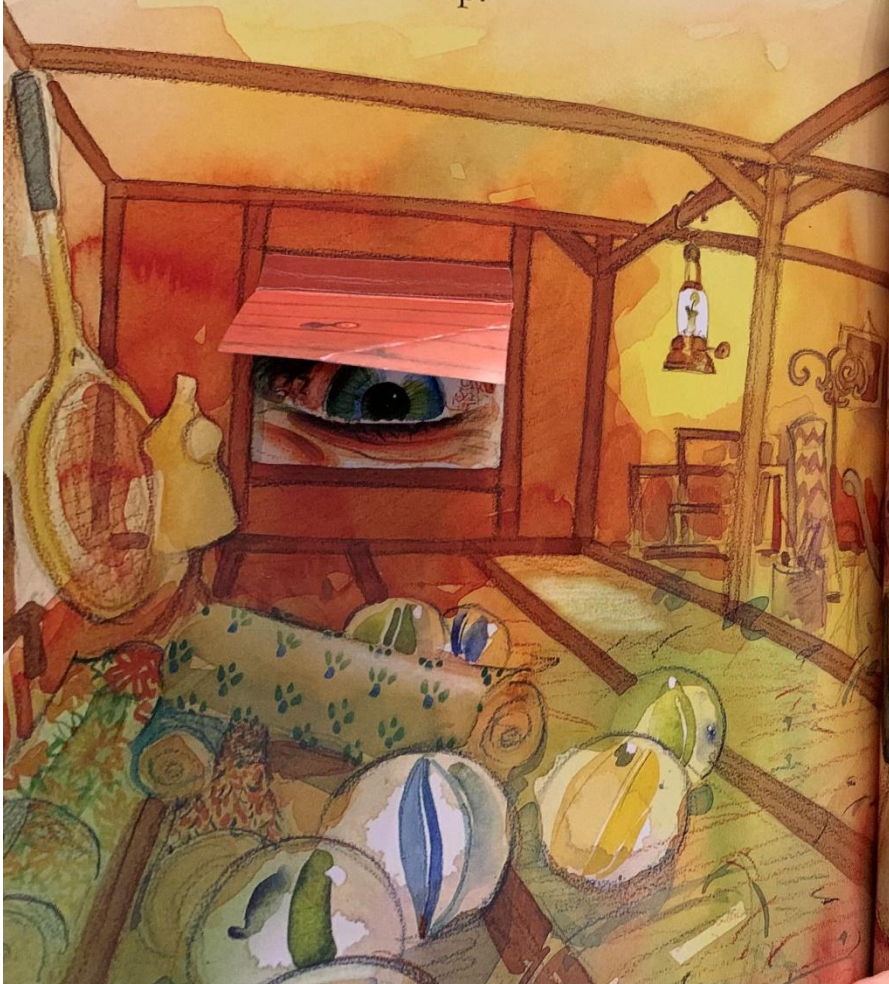


Quick,

in case he heard us!

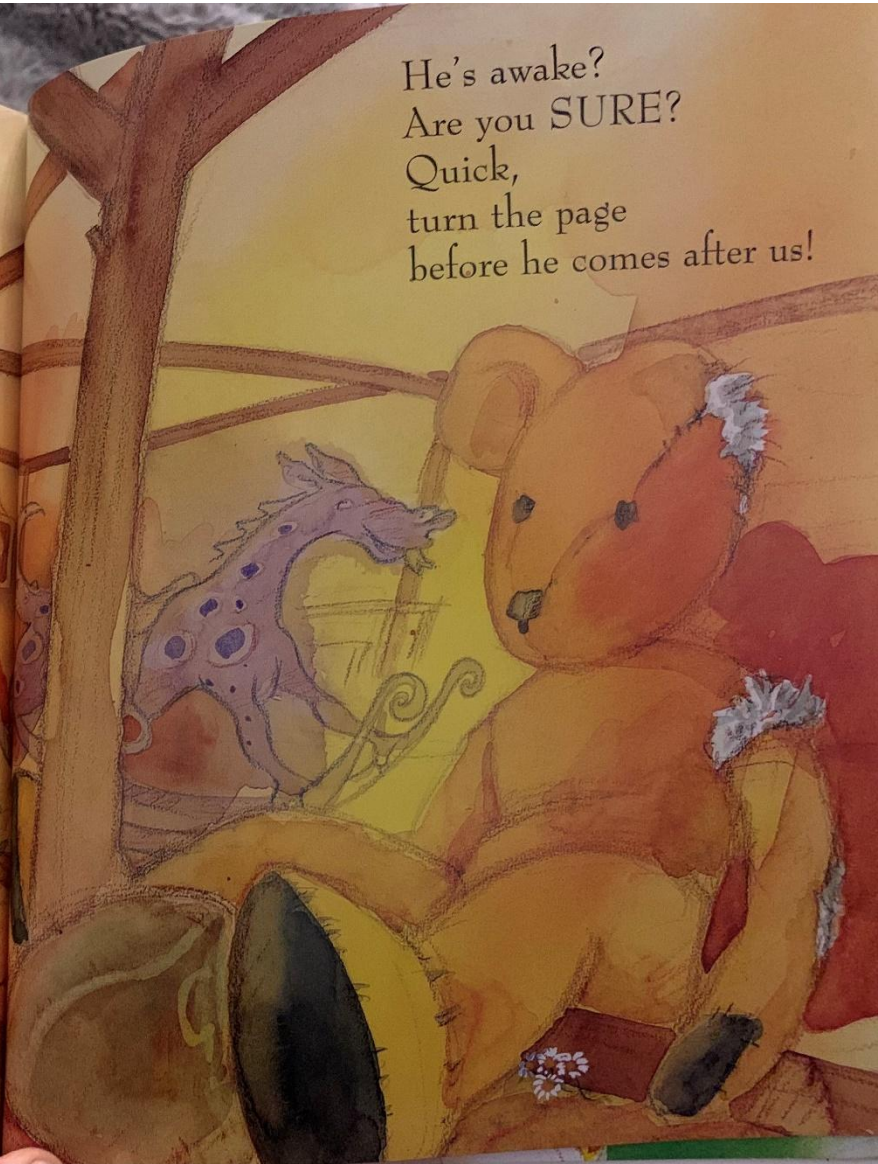




Do you think we woke him up?

and see if he's still asleep.

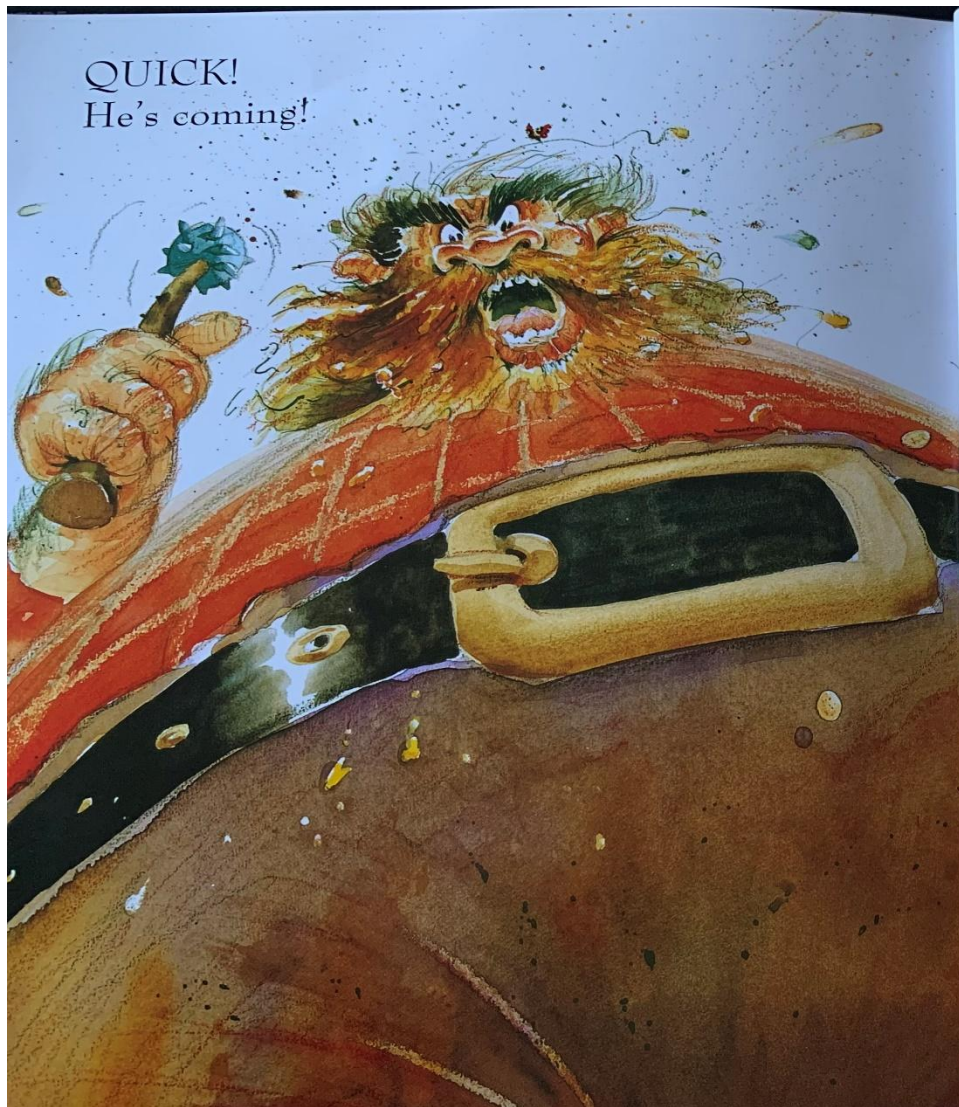


He's awake?

before he comes after us!

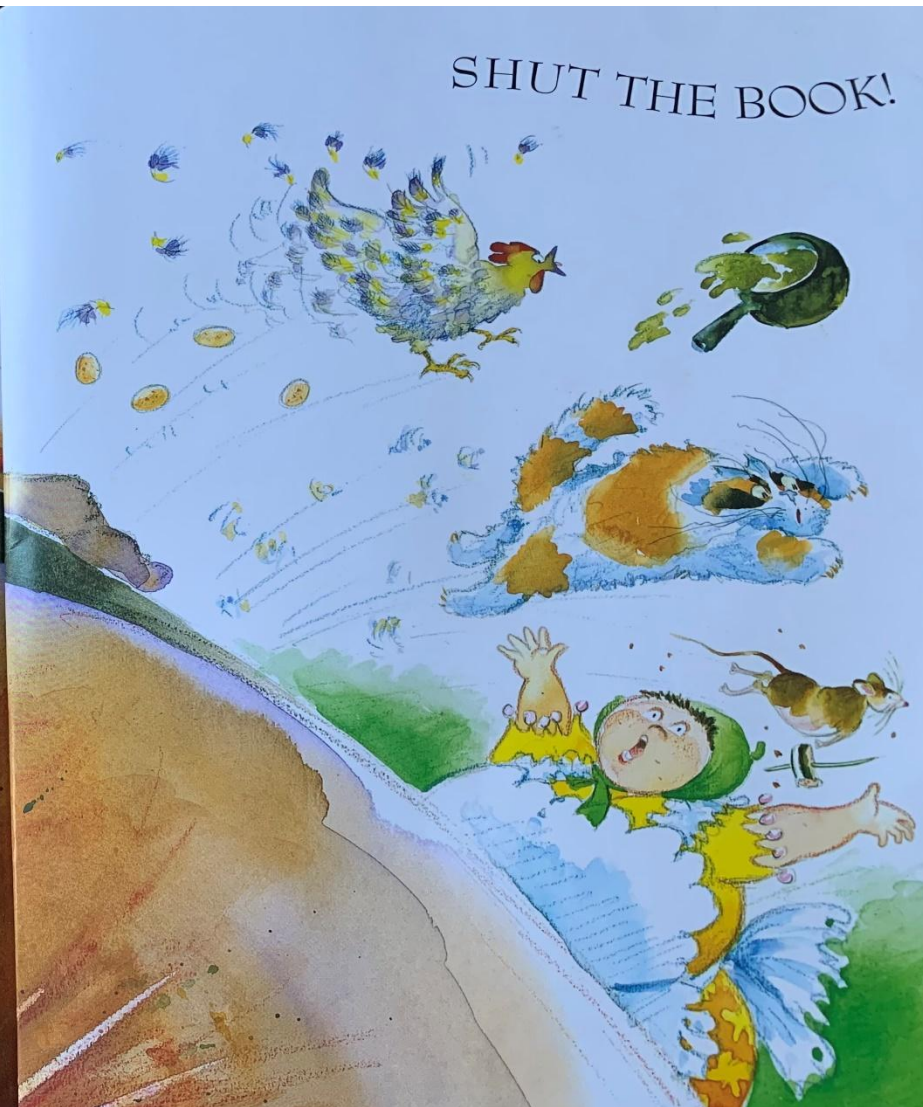
