

| Wednesday | To explore the characters and plot in a story | <p>Read The Caravan (see PP)</p> <p>Practise retelling the story.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tell a friend - Draw a story map  <p>- Tell the story</p> | <p>HOT SEATING to explore characters:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Write 3 questions you'd like to ask Mum at the beginning of the story and 3 more you'd like to ask her at the end - Write 3 questions you'd like to ask the boys as they set off on their adventure - Write 3 questions you'd like to ask the boys at the end <p>Write down answers to your own questions. | Thursday | Discuss the key themes in a story | <p>What could the key themes be in The Caravan?</p> <p>Encourage children to relate to other known warning stories. Discuss how the story hinges around the main character disobeying what they are told to do, which leads to a disaster, rescue and in the end a lesson learned.</p> <p>E.G. Little Red Riding Hood.</p> | <p>Read through Alice's story – see how the story structure has been used and innovated to create a similar, but unique warning story.</p> <p>Activity 1: Chn to identify what Alice has changed.</p> <p>Similarities / Differences grid in books comparing Alice's story with the original</p> | <p>The Caravan PP</p> <p>Story map</p> <p>Alice's story</p> | Plan Warning Theme Innovation |
