
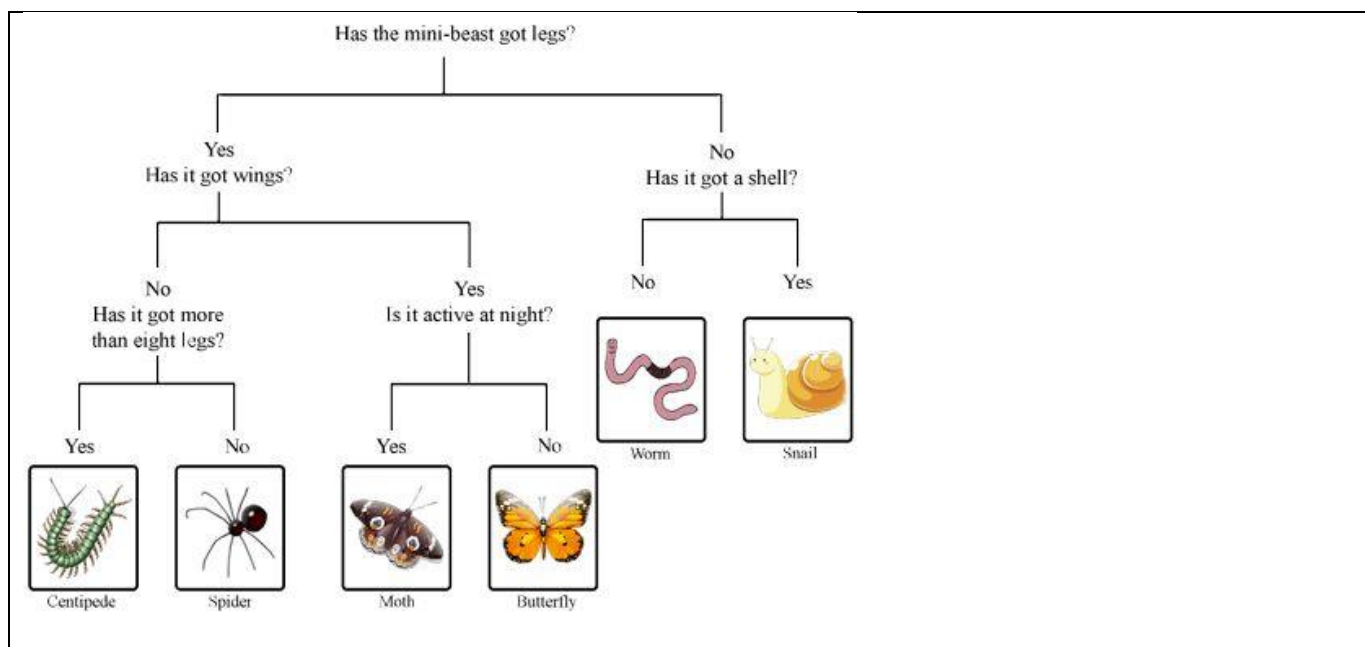

<b>Minibeasts Activities</b>			
<p>Choose a minibeast to write a riddle or Kennings poem about. Once complete, send your riddle or Kennings poem to us on Class Dojo. We'll post it ready for your classmates to guess the minibeast! E.g.</p> <p>Egg layer</p> <p>People scarer</p> <p>Trap preparer</p> <p>Fly adorer</p> <p>Web creator</p>			
<p>Natural objects make wonderful art materials. Make a minibeast using natural materials, e.g. twigs, leaves, straw, grass, etc.</p> 			
<p>Use this easy salt dough recipe to create a salt dough minibeast:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 cupful of plain flour (about 250g)</li> <li>• half a cupful of table salt (about 125g)</li> <li>• half a cupful of water (about 125ml)</li> </ul> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Preheat the oven to its lowest setting and line a baking sheet with baking parchment.</li> <li>2. Mix the flour and salt in a large bowl. Add the water and stir until it comes together into a ball.</li> <li>3. Transfer the dough to a floured work surface and shape into your chosen minibeast.</li> <li>4. Put your finished items on the lined baking sheet and bake for 3 hrs or until solid.</li> <li>5. Leave to cool and then paint.</li> </ol>			
<p>Go on a minibeast hunt, making a list of the minibeasts you find. Choose 6 different minibeasts from your list. How could you sort these minibeasts? Create a classification key like the one shown below.</p>			



I would like you to imagine you are a professional biologist who has just discovered an exciting new species of minibeast. You could:

- Create a poster - draw and label your new minibeast. What name will you give your animal?
- Create a fact file including information on where in the world you made the discovery, the minibeast's habitat, what your new minibeast eats, what eats your minibeast and its behaviour. Does your new minibeast have any special features?
