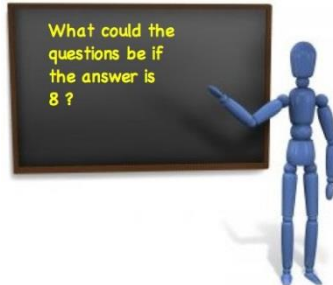


# It Was 2010!

Well I know that some teachers often use an idea like,



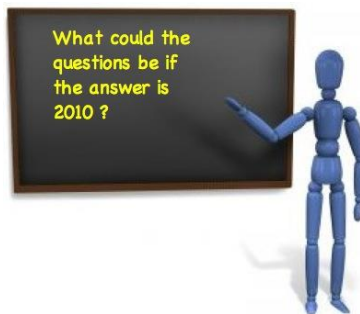
The pupils would get things like:
