# Your task is to write a newspaper report about a sporting event.

Next, you could...

- Talk to a family member who remembers the 2012 Olympics and ask them what they remember.
- Listen carefully to what the commentators in the clip say, then mute the sound and have a go at commentating the race yourself.
- Pretend to interview his wife, his old PE teacher, Mo himself and a spectator from the audience (get family members to go in the hot seat!).
- Look at some photos of the race and write captions for them.
- Read some real newspaper reports about the race from 2012 and look at how they are written.
- Think of a great headline.
- Plan your newspaper report, based on what you've found out.



### **Hedgehog Class**

In your writing you need to include:

- Catchy headline
- Facts about the main event what, where, when and who
- Finger spaces between words
- **Correct letter formation** so it can be easily read.

#### **Swift Class**

In your writing you need to include:

- Catchy headline
- Introduction: what, where, when and who
- Facts and details about the main event
- Past tense verbs
- Pictures with captions

### **Bees and Butterfly Class**

In your writing you need to include:

- Catchy **headline** to grab the readers' attention
- Introduction containing detail: what, where, when, why and who
- Facts in chronological order
- Paragraph your writing. New paragraph for new section/new piece of information
- Pictures with captions summarising the picture
- Writing in third person (use pronouns such as he/she/they) and past tense
- Include a direct quotation using speech marks correctly
- Formal language
- A conclusion paragraph
