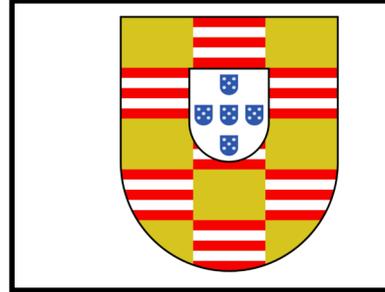

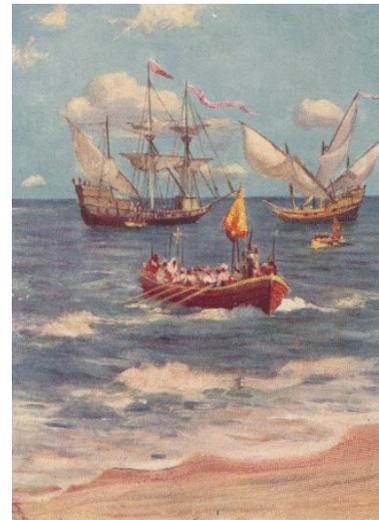

Who is Vasco da Gama?

Vasco da Gama was a Portuguese explorer and navigator. He was born in 1460 into a noble family. Little is known of his early life. Da Gama was born in Sines, Portugal. His birthday was June 5th, 1460. According to some people's accounts, he was a knight in the 1490s. He was appointed the position of leading voyages to secure an ocean route to the East, in the hope that spices from Africa and Asia could be brought back to Europe to sell. Vasco da Gama opened up a new world of riches by opening up an Indian Ocean route. That route is still used today.



What is Vasco da Gama famous for?

Vasco da Gama was the first European to find an ocean trading route to India. He accomplished what many explorers could not do. This discovery of the sea route helped the Portuguese establish a long lasting colonial empire in Asia and Africa. Spices from these places were sold for big sums of money in Europe, so this boosted the Portuguese economy. His voyages and explorations helped change the world for Europeans.
