Permission and Voluntary Contribution

Arrival Time	Make sure that your child is in school promptly at 8:45am . We will be travelling by coach and leaving at 9:00am
Return Time	Usual school time <i>On the day, if there is a delay to our return, information will be shared on Class Dojo.</i>
Clothing	The children should wear normal school uniform but with comfortable shoes (trainers). Please keep an eye on the weather and provide hats / rain coats, as needed. Sunscreen will need to be applied before school on the morning of the trip.
Lunch	Please provide your child with a packed lunch and water bottle , no fizzy drinks. <i>School is able to provide a packed lunch (£2.30) if it is booked. We will need to know by Monday 27th June, please let the office know.</i>
Equipment	Children should have their lunch and water bottles in a rucksack that they can carry around with them.
