## **Hedgehogs Class**

### Thursday 4th March

9 am Story time - Watch and enjoy as many of our recorded Mr Men stories as you want. If you have any Mr Men books of your own, you could read one or two of those too. Use the links on the first page.

10 am Explore Emotions - Look at the four Mr Men. Where is your happy place? For example, home, park, school. What is in your happy place? For example, flowers, books, favourite toy. Who is with you? For example, friends, family, pets. Draw a picture of your happy place.

#### 12 pm Lunch

1pm - Play 'feelings charades' using real and invented Mr Men and Little Miss characters. For example, happy, sad, surprised, angry, scared. Take turns to act out characters whilst the others guess which one.

2 pm Mr Potato Head - Make your own character using a potato – use paint, pipe cleaners, googly eyes and anything else you like to create your character! Make it brightly coloured and bold, like one of the Mr Men or Little Miss characters.



### Friday 5th March

(by 12 pm Potato Trail - Put your completed Mr Men or Little Miss potato character at the locations on the first page for others to admire.)

9 am Mr Potato Head adventure – Your Mr Potato Head has been on adventures in your house! Where has your Mr Potato Head been? What has he been doing? Take photos of your Mr Potato Head in five different locations in your house to show me what they have been doing.

10 am **Story Sequencing** – Print your five photos (or draw the locations) and sequence them in the right order on a story map. Retell Mr Potato's adventures: what did he do first, then, after that, next and finally?


11 am **Story writing** – Write the correct time word next to each image on your story map and write about Mr Potato's adventures.

#### 12 pm Lunch

1 pm Shape characters – Look at the shapes of the Mr Men - circle, triangle, rectangle and square. Draw, colour and cut out your own Mr Small, Mr Rush, Mr Grumpy and Mr Strong.


