

Science	To observe and measure	Today we will measure and compare our body parts – feet, hands, etc.  Model how to measure accurately, using cm and nonstandard units e.g. multilink cubes. Geography	To create a map	Look at a map of London and remind chn of the landmarks we learnt about – the River Thames, Big Ben, London Eye etc.  Today we will look at a map of the school grounds and then create our own map. Look at Google map image and satellite image of the school and discuss. What can we identify from the map and satellite image?  Explain that a map is a 'birds' eye view', looking down on what's below – so we only see the top of everything.
