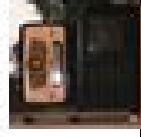

In 1939, when Hitler invaded Poland, Britain listened to the radio as Chamberlain announced that we were at war with Germany.



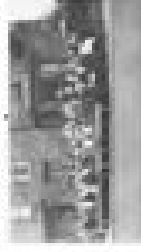
Hitler became Chancellor of Germany in 1933. He started to take back land that they'd lost in the World War 1.
