<b>Monday</b>	LO: to explore a text.	<p>ZOOM</p> <p>Share the 'Amazing Aliens' text by reading together.</p> <p>Discuss the meaning of the following words by giving two pictures and deciding which one best shows the vocabulary:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Humanoid</li> <li>• Cocoon</li> <li>• Vegetarian</li> </ul> <p>Show how to describe using adjectives and prepositions – including the use of a colour thesaurus to pick unusual colours, e.g. hickory, azure, emerald, etc.</p>	<p>Use the given pictures of aliens or find an alien picture yourself.</p> <p>Describe the alien using only four adjectives and one preposition for each body part, e.g. the alien I saw had sangria—red, oval eyes on top of long, stretchy stalks.</p> <p>Remember to use the colour thesaurus to make your sentences interesting.</p>	Zoom meeting link, colour thesaurus, alien sheet with pictures or your own alien picture.	Non-chronological report, definition, vocabulary, adjectives, prepositions.
<b>Tuesday</b>	LO: to use compound words.	<p>ZOOM</p> <p>Recap the Amazing Alien facts from the non-chronological report. Pay particular attention to the word 'candyarian' – this is a made up, alien word.</p> <p>Compound words are made when two words are joined to form a new word, e.g. blackboard, snowman, greenhouse, etc. Can you think of any other compound words?</p>	<p>We are going to make up our own 'alien' words by joining the split parts of compound words together, e.g. snowman + watermelon = snowmelon -&gt; fruit that grows on frozen space-trees in winter.</p> <p>Write a list of 8 compound words, splitting them into their parts. Join a word from column 1 with a word from column 2 to make a new alien word. Give it a definition and put it into a sentence.</p>	Zoom meeting link, compound word sheet.	Compound word, definition, sentence, parts.
<b>Wednesday</b>	LO: to answer questions about a text.	<p>Re-read the Amazing Aliens non-chronological report.</p> <p>Recap the new vocabulary from yesterday's lesson – humanoid, cocoon, vegetarian.</p>	Use your retrieval and inference skills to answer the comprehension question about the Amazing Aliens text.	Amazing Aliens text, comprehension questions.	Inference, retrieval, questions, comprehension.
