Wednesday	To read words with split digraphs	<p>We have learnt different ways to spell long vowel sounds ai, ee, igh, oa and ue.</p> <p>One way to spell each of these is with a split digraph</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a_e (came) - e_e (these) - i_e (kite) - o_e (phone) - u_e (tune) <p>The 'e' on the end of each word makes the vowel in the middle say its long sound (its letter name), not its short sound.</p>	<p>Play the roll and read game:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - roll the die and choose a word from the correct row to read. - for more of a challenge, say your chosen word in a sentence or test yourself on how to spell it. 	<p>Split digraph roll and read activity</p> <p>One die</p>
