Write 4 division and 4 multiplication questions.

2. Amir thinks of a number. He multiplies it by 100.

The answer has the same digit in the thousands and hundreds columns.

The total of all the digits is 8.

What could the number be?

3. Alex is thinking of a number. She divides it by 100.

The answer has one more in the hundreds column than in the tens column.

The total of the digits is 15.

What could the number be? How many different answers can you find?
