

Spring Term Curriculum Map Year 5/6

History & Geography



In history, we will be learning about World War II and answering the question: Should Britain have gone to war?

In geography, we will be exploring natural and artificial borders of Europe. How have they changed since World War II?

P.E

In PE, we will be exploring Dance and Gymnastics.

We will be practising our balancing, both individually and as pairs.

PSHE

This term, we will be exploring diversity and community. We will be exploring our own identity and that of others.

Science

We will be learning about different types of forces. We will investigate air resistance and water resistance and what affects these types of friction.

RE - Hinduism



How do questions about Brahman and Atman influence the way a Hindu lives?

Music

We will be learning about chords and how the notes compliment each other.

Computing

Programming - we will be working towards writing and testing algorithms. We will learn to combine outputs and control them with conditions.

Art & DT



In Art, we will be exploring modernism. We will study 20th century art by Pablo Picasso, Barbara Hepworth and Auerbach. We will be practising and improving our art and design techniques including drawing and painting with a range of materials.

In DT, we will be making our own soup using rationing recipes from WWII.

English



In English, we will be reading and innovating a story called 'The Caravan' with a World War II twist.

We will then be writing persuasive information texts about World War II planes. We will continue our ongoing grammar learning, looking at the passive voice, subjunctive mood and cohesion.

Maths



This term, we will finish our fractions unit, learning how to multiply and divide fractions by either integers or fractions.

We will also learn how to convert between fractions, decimals and percentages.

In fluency, we will continue to practise recall of number facts, e.g. multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000.

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
