

Summer Term Curriculum Map Year 3/4

History & Geography



In History, we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians. We will use sources of evidence to learn about pyramids, gods and goddesses.

In Geography, we will be exploring the importance of the River Nile and its human and physical features.

P.E



In PE, we will be developing our netball skills building up to playing small games. Later in the term, our swimming lessons will begin focusing on water confidence and technique.

PSHE



This term, we will be looking at drug education, in particular, medicines. We will begin our Relationships and Sex Education unit looking at the physical differences between males and females and naming body parts.

Science



In Science, we will be learning about magnets. We will explore magnetic forces looking at attraction and repulsion. Later in the term, we will explore sound including how sounds are made, vibrations, pitch and volume.

RE - Christianity



What do Christians understand by the Kingdom of God?

We will be exploring what the Kingdom of God means to Christians.

Music



In Music, we will be thinking ahead to our end of year KS2 production and learning the songs ready to perform to you!

French



In French we will be learning numbers to 10, conversational language and names of colours and animals.

Computing



In Computing, we will be using desktop publishing software to create, edit and improve documents.

Art & DT



In Art, we will use a variety of techniques using clay to create an Egyptian cartouche and canopic jar.

In DT, we will use the technique of applique to create an Egyptian collar. We will develop, create and evaluate our designs.

English



In English, we will be using 'The Egyptian Cinderella' by Shirley Climo to write a diary entry as the main character, Rhodopis. Following this, we will be using our knowledge of the mummification process to write an explanation of how this happens. Later in the term, we will write a short story similar to 'How the Camel got his Hump' followed by a discussion surrounding who was the greatest Egyptian leader.

Maths



This term, we will complete our learning on fractions before moving on to learning about money and decimals.

We will move onto learning about statistics and time as well as position and direction.

We will continue to learn our times tables through our fluency sessions.
