How many boxes can be filled?

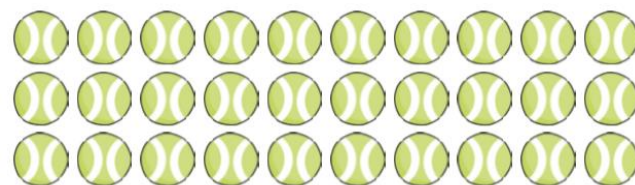
Did you use sharing or grouping?
