YEAR 1 PHONICS SCREENING

WHEN

- In June each year for Year I
- Re-takes the following June for Year 2

WHY

- They are statutory
- They provide a standardised score which can be compared to national averages

WHO

- Administered by class teacher (or another phonics-trained member of staff who is familiar to the children)
 - All Year I pupils take the screening test

WHERE

• Tests are administered individually in a quiet space, away from other children and distractions

WHAT


- 40 words to read aloud: some real words and some non-words
 - Not timed but lasts about 10 minutes
- Can be done in parts with breaks if necessary


